



Collar County Capital Plan Highlights

Road & Bridge Projects

- \$131 million for additional lane and bridge reconstruction at U.S. Route 30 from east of Williams Street to U.S. Route 45 and from U.S. Route 45 to Illinois Route 43
- \$125 million for additional lanes at Illinois Route 59 from Ferry Road to Aurora Avenue in Naperville
- \$82 million for Algonquin by-pass route of Illinois Route 31 west of downtown Algonquin
- \$45 million for interchange construction at Interstate Route 57 at Stuenkel Road
- \$32 million for additional lanes at U.S. Route 45 from Washington Street to Illinois Route 120

21st Century Transportation

- \$7 billion for a 21st century transportation network in Illinois, including:
 - \$2.7 billion for Chicago-area public transit, leveraging up to \$2.7 billion in additional federal funds
 - \$400 million for high-speed rail, which could access up to \$2 billion in ARRA funds (statewide)
 - \$322 million for the Chicago Region Environmental and Transportation Efficiency Program (CREATE)
 - \$110.5 million for the third airport project

P-12 Education:

- \$3.6 billion in P-12 education across the state, highlights include:
 - \$3 billion for the school construction program (statewide)
 - \$200 million for the school maintenance program (statewide)
 - \$196 million charter schools (statewide)
 - \$100 million for a new school energy efficiency retrofit program (statewide)
 - \$45 million for a new early childhood facilities program (statewide)
 - \$10 million for student laptop computers (statewide)

Higher Education

- \$36 million to College of Lake County to construct the student services building
- \$25 million to College of DuPage - Glen Ellyn to replace temporary facilities
- \$22.5 million to Northern Illinois University to expand/renovate the Stevens Building
- \$8 million to Northern Illinois University to renovate Cole Hall
- \$6.3 million to the Illinois Math and Science Academy to renovate residence halls
- \$672,000 to McHenry County College to construct a greenhouse

Community Development Projects

- \$830 million in community development projects across Illinois, including:
 - \$300 million for park and recreational facilities (statewide)
 - \$150 million for health care facilities (statewide)
 - \$130 million for affordable housing, including projects for veterans and people with disabilities (statewide)
 - \$100 million for museums (statewide)
 - \$100 million for public libraries (statewide) o \$50 million for community health center construction (statewide)

Economic Development Projects

- \$2.5 billion in economic development projects across Illinois, including:
 - \$715 million for state facilities (statewide)
 - \$425 million for Weatherization and Energy Efficiency (statewide)
 - \$50 million for broadband deployment (statewide)
 - \$38 million for River's Edge and Brownfield projects to clean up contaminated sites (statewide)
 - \$25 million for Prime Sites program to develop local infrastructure and create jobs (statewide)
 - \$17 million to the Fermi National Accelerator Lab (Batavia) the Illinois Accelerator Research Center
 - \$15 million for creation or retention of jobs in economically depressed areas (statewide)
 - \$13 million to the Argonne National Lab for Advanced Protein Crystallization Facility
 - \$10 million for fresh food program to bring grocery stores and other fresh food retailers into communities that need them (statewide) o \$5 million to BMI for a biodiesel plant

Environmental Projects

- \$1.3 billion for environmental projects across Illinois, highlights include:
 - \$516 million for the drinking and wastewater revolving loans (statewide)
 - \$250 million for projects such as levees, flood walls and drainage structures (statewide)
 - \$225 million for the Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (statewide)
 - \$128 million for Army Corp restoration programs (statewide)
 - \$75 million for leaking underground storage tank program (statewide)
 - \$41 million for dam removal and repair (statewide)
 - \$25 million for open land trust program (statewide)
 - \$10 million for dam safety programs (statewide) o \$8 million for “mud to parks” park restoration program (statewide)
