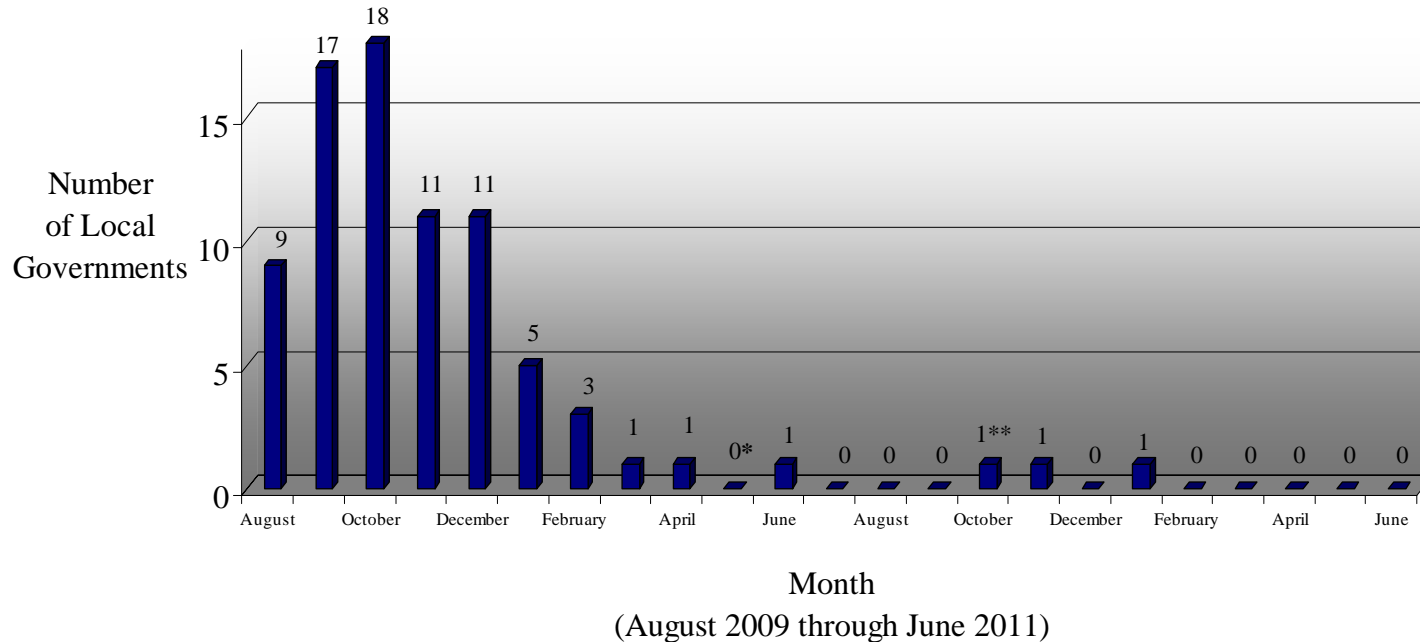




Of the more than 1,200 local governments in Illinois that can act on Video Gambling, 80 have taken some type of action.

* In May, Kane County reversed its ban on video gaming, voting 17-7 to support the Illinois capital plan and the 439,000 jobs it will create.

** In October, the City of Waterloo opted into the Video Gaming Act, and the Village of Mundelein passed a temporary opt-out ordinance, but the Village is required to take a final vote on the issue when the rules are finalized by the Illinois Gaming Board.
